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The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Complaint inspection.

This inspection was conducted on the following date(s): February 18, 2015

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with the Administrator, the Director of Care, 3 Personal Support Workers, 3 Registered Practical Nurses, 1 Registered Nurse and 1 Laundry Aide.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector conducted a tour of resident areas, observed residents and the care provided to them. Clinical records for identified residents were reviewed. The inspector reviewed records, policies and procedures.

WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 89. Laundry service Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 89. (1) As part of the organized program of laundry services under clause 15 (1) (b) of the Act, every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that, (b) a sufficient supply of clean linen, face cloths and bath towels are always available in the home for use by residents; O. Reg. 79/10, s. 89 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants:



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1. The licensee has failed to ensure that sufficient supply of clean linens, face cloths and bath towels are always available in the home for use by the resident as evidenced by;

Observations revealed three top sheets and three bottom sheets for bed linen supplies on a linen cart in a home care area.

An interview with a staff member revealed there were not enough linens on the cart to complete the five bed changes required on that shift.

An interview with the laundry department revealed only half of the quantities can go up to the home care areas as there are not always a sufficient supply of clean linens available.

An interview with the Administrator confirmed it was the homes expectation to ensure that sufficient supply of clean linens, face cloths and bath towels were always available in the home for use by the resident. [s. 89. (1) (b)]

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that sufficient supply of clean linens, face cloths and bath towels are always available in the home for use by the resident, to be implemented voluntarily.

WN #2: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 129. Safe storage of drugs



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Specifically failed to comply with the following:

- s. 129. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that,
- (a) drugs are stored in an area or a medication cart,
 - (i) that is used exclusively for drugs and drug-related supplies,
 - (ii) that is secure and locked,
- (iii) that protects the drugs from heat, light, humidity or other environmental conditions in order to maintain efficacy, and
- (iv) that complies with manufacturer's instructions for the storage of the drugs; and O. Reg. 79/10, s. 129 (1).
- (b) controlled substances are stored in a separate, double-locked stationary cupboard in the locked area or stored in a separate locked area within the locked medication cart. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 129 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants:

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that drugs are stored in an area or a medication cart that is used exclusively for drugs and drug-related supplies as evidenced by;

Observations revealed two topical medications in a Resident bathroom and bedroom. An interview with the Director of Care confirmed the topical medications were not stored correctly and it was the homes expectation that the medications be stored in a lockable treatment cart. [s. 129. (1) (a)]

Additional Required Actions:

VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance to ensure that drugs are stored in an area or a medication cart that is used exclusively for drugs and drug-related supplies, to be implemented voluntarily.
