Duty to protect

s. 24 (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall protect residents from abuse by anyone and shall ensure that residents are not neglected by the licensee or staff.

The licensee failed to protect a resident from physical abuse by a visitor.

In accordance with the definition identified in Ontario Regulation 246/22 section 2, "physical abuse" means the use of physical force by anyone other than a resident that causes physical injury or pain.

A resident was pushed by a visitor, resulting in a fall and subsequent pain to the resident's head. The resident was transferred to the hospital the next day, due to a headache and neck pain. Registered Nurse (RN) #101, #102, and Associate Director of Resident Care (ADRC) confirmed the resident had been physically abused by the visitor.
