**Specifically failed to comply with the following:**

**s. 53. (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the following are developed to meet the needs of residents with responsive behaviours:**

- 1. Written approaches to care, including screening protocols, assessment, reassessment and identification of behavioural triggers that may result in responsive behaviours, whether cognitive, physical, emotional, social, environmental or other.** O. Reg. 79/10, s. 53 (1).
- 2. Written strategies, including techniques and interventions, to prevent, minimize or respond to the responsive behaviours.** O. Reg. 79/10, s. 53 (1).
- 3. Resident monitoring and internal reporting protocols.** O. Reg. 79/10, s. 53 (1).
- 4. Protocols for the referral of residents to specialized resources where required.** O. Reg. 79/10, s. 53 (1).

**Findings/Faits saillants :**

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that written strategies include techniques and interventions to prevent, minimize or respond to the responsive behaviours

Interview with Director of Resident Care confirmed the care plan under the focus of Wandering only had interventions of :

- a) maintaining a consistent routine and provide a calendar and orientate resident to person place and time.
- b) PCP staff to report if resident cannot be found outside on the grounds.

Care plan review revealed no interventions related to wandering such as:

- a) staff to confirm resident's whereabouts at start of every shift and q1 hours as ordered by physician
  - b) approaches or responses for staff to use when resident is wanting to leave the home
- c) locations that resident has been known to go to (list)
- b) role and responsibility of the supplemental staffing.

Interview with Director of Resident Care confirmed these interventions were discussed and it is the home's expectation that these interventions would have been written into the care plan to potentially prevent resident from wandering away. [s. 53. (1) 2.]
