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WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 8. Policies, etc., to be followed, and records

Specifically failed to comply with the following:

s. 8. (1) Where the Act or this Regulation requires the licensee of a long-term care home to have, institute or otherwise put in place any plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system, the licensee is required to ensure that the plan, policy, protocol, procedure, strategy or system,
(a) is in compliance with and is implemented in accordance with applicable requirements under the Act; and O. Reg. 79/10, s. 8 (1).
(b) is complied with. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 8 (1).

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The Licensee failed to ensure that the home's policy for pain assessment was followed.

A resident sustained a fall. The resident complained of pain. The resident continued to report worsening pain for the next two days. The home's policy entitled "Pain Assessment and Symptom Management" states that "when a resident has new or changes in level of pain a pain monitoring tool will be initiated" and that "the physician will be notified when the resident reports sudden onset of new pain or worsening pain". Following the resident's fall, a pain assessment tool was not initiated and contact with the physician was not made for 2 days. The resident was transferred to hospital and was diagnosed with an injury.

The Administrator confirmed that the home's policy was not followed. [s. 8. (1) (b)]
