The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a Complaint inspection.

A cooling and air temperature inspection was also completed as part of this inspection “Air Temperature Monitoring”

During the course of the inspection, the inspector(s) spoke with residents, a Personal Support Worker (PSW), a Registered Practical Nurse (RPN), the IPAC Lead, a Housekeeper, the Maintenance Assistant, a Registered Nurse (RN) and the Administrator.

Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007 (LTCHA) was found. (a requirement under the LTCHA includes the requirements contained in the items listed in the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA).

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

Le non-respect des exigences de la Loi de 2007 sur les foyers de soins de longue durée (LFSLD) a été constaté. (une exigence de la loi comprend les exigences qui font partie des éléments énumérés dans la définition de « exigence prévue par la présente loi », au paragraphe 2(1) de la LFSLD).

**WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 21. Air temperature
Specifically failed to comply with the following:**

s. 21. (2) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that the temperature is measured and documented in writing, at a minimum in the following areas of the home:

1. At least two resident bedrooms in different parts of the home. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 21 (2).

Findings/Faits saillants :

1. The licensee has failed to ensure that the temperature in the home was measured and documented in writing in at least two resident bedrooms in different parts of the home.

The Daily Air Temperatures chart for the week of August 17-August 24, 2021, identified the air temperature had been taken in one resident room per shift daily.

A RN stated the temperatures were taken three times daily in one resident room.

The Administrator stated that they were aware of r. 21. (2) 1. and the home had not been recording the temperature from two different resident rooms.

Home Policy "Monitoring Building Temperatures & Humidity", Reviewed and Updated August 10, 2021, stated the Home shall monitor, measure and record the air temperature and humidity three times daily in at least two resident bedrooms in different parts of the home.

There was minimal risk of harm to the residents related to the temperature not being monitored in two resident rooms.
