The licensee has failed to provide a detailed explanation of the supporting facts, as they relate to the home and to the applicant's condition and requirements for care, when they withheld approval for admission.

Rationale and Summary

The Local Health Integration Network (LHIN) submitted an application for an applicant to be admitted to the home. The home declined the application indicating a specific applicant condition, and that the home did not have the nursing/staffing expertise or resources to manage their care needs as they relate to their condition.

The assessment form that the home received from the LHIN did not include any details indicating the applicant had a history of the specific condition. Interview with the members of the home's admission committee indicated that the home did not request further assessments from the LHIN's coordinator about the applicant's specific condition prior to declining the application and that the refusal letter did not include a detailed explanation of the supporting facts, as they relate



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both to the home and to the applicant's condition and requirements for care.

Failure to ensure a detailed explanation of the supporting facts in the response letter compromised their ability to participate in the long-term care placement process.
