Duty to protect

s. 24 (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall protect residents from abuse by anyone and shall ensure that residents are not neglected by the licensee or staff.

"Sexual abuse" means any non-consensual touching, behaviour or remarks of a sexual nature or sexual exploitation directed towards a resident by a person other than a licensee or staff member".

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A video footage showed that a resident exhibited inappropriate behaviours towards other residents. The Director of Care (DOC) acknowledged that the resident displayed inappropriate behaviours towards co-residents.
