#### Non-compliance with: O. Reg. 246/22, s. 11 (1) (b)

Policies, etc., to be followed, and records

s. 11 (1) Where the Act or this Regulation requires the licensee of a long-term care home to have, institute or otherwise put in place any plan, policy, protocol, program, procedure, strategy, initiative or system, the licensee is required to ensure that the plan, policy, protocol, program, procedure, strategy, initiative or system, (b) is complied with.

In accordance with O. Reg. 226/22, s. 11 (1) (b), the licensee is required to ensure the home's Fall Prevention and Management policy was complied with.

O. Reg. 226/22, s. 54 (1) requires that the program includes strategies to reduce or mitigate falls, and the monitoring of residents after falls.

The licensee has failed to comply with their Falls Prevention and Management program:

- a) To initiate and to complete a Head Injury Routine protocol , for a resident who had a fall; and
- b) To update the care plan with a new fall strategy after a resident had a fall.
