Safe storage of drugs

s. 138 (1) Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that,

(b) controlled substances are stored in a separate, double-locked stationary cupboard in the locked area or stored in a separate locked area within the locked medication cart.

The licensee has failed to ensure that the supply of resident weekly narcotic controlled substance medication cards and an emergency supply of an injectable medication were stored in a separate, double-locked stationary cupboard in a locked medication room.

Sources: Observations of the 2nd and 3rd floor medication rooms; record review of the Extendicare Management of Insulin, Narcotics, and Controlled Drugs policy and procedure; and interviews with a Registered Practical Nurse (RPN) and an Assistant Director Of Care (ADOC).
