Inspection Summary/Résumé de l'inspection

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Non-compliance with requirements under the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007 (LTCHA) was found. (A requirement under the LTCHA includes the requirements contained in the items listed in the definition of "requirement under this Act" in subsection 2(1) of the LTCHA.)

The following constitutes written notification of non-compliance under paragraph 1 of section 152 of the LTCHA.

**WN #1: The Licensee has failed to comply with O.Reg 79/10, s. 16. Every licensee of a long-term care home shall ensure that every window in the home that opens to the outdoors and is accessible to residents has a screen and cannot be opened more than 10 centimetres. O. Reg. 79/10, s. 16.**

**Findings/Faits sayants :**

1. On 10 June 2011, the inspector randomly checked 67 resident-accessible windows in the seven resident home areas (RHA). Two windows on the 4th floor did not have their openings restricted to 10 centimetres; one resident's room in the Hidden Valley RHA and the living room in the Spencer Creek RHA. The lever arms were no longer attached at the bottom of the windows thus allowing them to be fully opened.

The windows in both these areas were repaired by the environmental services supervisor during the inspection and were confirmed by the inspector to be secured and restricted.

**Additional Required Actions:**

***VPC - pursuant to the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, S.O. 2007, c.8, s.152(2) the licensee is hereby requested to prepare a written plan of correction for achieving compliance for ensuring that every window that opens to the outdoors and is accessible to residents cannot be opened more than 10 centimetres, to be implemented voluntarily.***
